**PUBLISHED TESTS, MEASUREMENT INSTRUMENTS:**

I am a coauthor of many of the instruments in the California Critical Thinking CCTST) family of instruments. The CCTST and other instruments in this group are used to test critical thinking skills and habits of mind around the world. My work includes translation projects with international scholars to achieve culturally competent, valid and reliable measures of critical thinking. These include multiple versions of the California Critical Thinking Skills Test (CCTST), California Critical Thinking Disposition Inventory (CCTDI), Business Critical Thinking Skills Test (BCTST), The Business Attitude Inventory (BAI), the Health Sciences Reasoning Test (HSRT), and the Legal Studies Reasoning Profile (LSRP). These tests are used for high stakes testing (proprietary). Other instruments developed by my research team include the Judgment to Delay Scale, the Perceived Prejudice in Health Care Scales, Habits of Health Care Utilization Scale, Perceived Access to Health Care Scale, and other measures of patient attitudes and behavior.
